Redding Rodeo Association Annual Scholarship Award \$1000.00

Eligibility:

- 1. Graduating Senior from any high school in Shasta County.
- **2.** Applications must be received by May 1st of the current school year.

Scholarship Committee:

- 1. The Scholarship Committee will consist of the current President, Vice President, Treasurer and Scholarship Chairman of the Redding Rodeo Association.
- 2. The Scholarship Committee screens applications and conducts a formal interview with each of the top six candidates.

Screening Applicants:

- 1. Initial screening is based on each candidate's points, one point being awarded for each of the following activities:
 - **a.** Daughter or son of a Redding Rodeo Association member or a member of any affiliate group.
 - **b**. Active participation in Future Farmers of America
 - c. Active participation in California High School Rodeo, District 1
 - **d.** Active participation in 4-H club work.
 - **e.** Active participation in California State Horseman's Association activities.
 - **f.** Seniors who have achieved a 3.5 or greater GPR.
- 2. During the interview, each finalist will be asked a set number of questions, dealing with their plans for college, degree major, financial need, community service, formal and extracurricular school activities, and clubs and other organizations to which they belong.

The Award:

- 1. The Award will be presented at the winner's high school's Awards Assembly.
- 2. A "Winning Scholarship" envelope containing instructions for the winner to verify their enrollment in the college of their choice will be given.
- **3.** A check for \$1000.00 to the college of their choice once verification is received by the Redding Rodeo Association.
